



Results-Based Protection

Field mission to initiate comprehensive field support for NGOs in Nigeria
Terms of Reference

Overview:

InterAction has undertaken two Protection-focused missions to Nigeria in the past 18 months, focused on identifying ways that the humanitarian response can work to reduce risk. This trip is meant to build on the previous missions and will focus on the challenges of protection analysis and decision-making in an increasingly complex context. This mission supports the field-level component of InterAction's SIDA-funded project, [Strengthening Ways of Working for Protection Outcomes](#).

Dates: November 25th – December 10th, 2019

Core Support Activities:

1. Workshops to Strengthen Results-Based Approaches to Protection

- Co-convening with Sida a discussion on Results-based Protection with the donor community
 - Discussion of donor successes and challenges in supporting NGO partners to achieve protection outcomes
 - Discussion on current protection priorities in Nigeria
 - Contribute to global donor-NGO dialogue on results-based protection
- Hold a working session with NGOs in Maiduguri that focuses on location-specific protection analysis
 - Identify results-based methods for protection analysis that can be incorporated into ongoing programming
 - Identify pathways where protection analysis can influence decision-making
- Hold a workshop on protection analysis tailored for local and national NGOs
 - Highlight ways local and national NGOs can support protection analysis across the response

2. Peer Exchange: Protection Analysis

- Peer Exchange and guided discussion on protection analysis successes with NGO practitioners
- Continued consultations/follow up with NGOs and other key stakeholders

3. Documentation of Results-Based Protection

- Carry out interviews and other methods (audio recording, photos, etc., if relevant) with NGO staff to document identified good practice
- Detailed documentation of discussions and results from working sessions and other meetings, highlighting learning coming out of the project

Anticipated outputs:

- Brief outcome document for NGOs participating in working sessions on protection analysis
- Write-up of donor meeting, including recommendations to HCT/donors/NGOs, if relevant
- Revised "Donor Tip Sheet"
- Identification of additional areas of support for NGOs
- Short, written case studies documenting RBP good practice and data that can feed into other RBP materials
