



## Strengthening Ways of Working for Protection Outcomes. 2021-2024

### Field Support for Collective Strategies

InterAction will continue working with interested NGOs to support and strengthen existing **Results-Based Protection** efforts to achieve protection outcomes. This initiative aims to complement ongoing efforts, without increasing the workload of NGO staff. InterAction's plays a facilitation role, meant to augment existing programming and build on current success. Through continuous remote engagement and occasional field visits, InterAction will work with NGOs and their partners to identify strategies to address collective protection priorities using results-based approaches.

#### Key Project Activities

- **Ongoing remote support** to a self-selecting group of NGOs, including providing resources, convening actors, and facilitating a dialogue on the use of results-based approaches to prioritize protection outcomes and develop **action plans** to achieve those outcomes
- **Field missions**, including consultations, workshops, and briefings with protection actors and the broader humanitarian community
- **An annual roundtable** for field practitioners, allowing the opportunity for peer exchange and to share learning more broadly
- **Documentation** of good practice, providing a platform for development and sharing of tools, methods, and strategies for implementation of results-based protection

#### Participating NGOs can expect

- **Improved protection analyses** using continuous context-specific tools and methodologies
- **Collective protection intervention strategies** that identify a clear causal logic between the intervention and reduction of risk
- **Increased multi-disciplinary thinking** as evidenced in program plans and strategy, including across the peacebuilding and development fields
- **Improved methods for measuring outcomes**, reflecting the complexity of measuring protection risks in dynamic humanitarian crises

#### What type of Support?

- Opportunities to learn and apply problem-solving methods and techniques, including those focused on program design and measurement
- Support on integrating methods to measure protection outcomes, including outcome mapping / harvesting, Most Significant Change, and more
- Multi-disciplinary and participatory workshops to develop context-specific theories of change
- Introducing iterative methods to help adapt programming in real-time
- Development of context-specific indicators that look at protection outcomes
- Creating baselines to support the monitoring and changes of risk patterns
- Sharing resources and materials of good and emerging practice
- Documenting efforts to help analyse, distil, and learn from good practice
- Facilitating interagency dialogue
- Building relationships for collective action
- Helping to identify opportunities for leverage, influence, and dialogue
- Other opportunities, capacity strengthening, or needs identified by NGOs and partners

**GOAL:** Increase the practical knowledge and use of results-based approaches to protection among NGO staff working in humanitarian crisis

**TIMELINE:** June 2021–March 2024

**TARGETED COUNTRIES:** Nigeria, other countries TBD
